Inlet Port



Collar– Unscrew to remove the port



- 1. Remove the back panel of the A2000.
- 2. Push a small screwdriver into the crimp of the clamp securing the broken inlet port.
- 3. Twist the screwdriver as shown to open the crimp.
- 4. Remove the tube from the port barb and discard the old clamp.
- 5. Remove the collar holding the inlet port to the cabinet.
- 6. Install the new inlet port and collar in the cabinet. Slide the screw clamp over the tube. Slide the tube over the port barb and tighten the screw clamp.
- 7. Attach the amylase dispenser and fill with water to check for leaks.

Note:

Extra tubing and an extra clamp have been provided in case the tubing is damaged during removal. In the event of damage, cut a new length of tubing and also remove the clamp to the "T". Clamp and install the new tubing and check for leaks.
